TEHRAN — Based on an agreement with Peugeot, Iranian carmaker Iran Khodro (IKCO) will produce Peugeot cars in its factories outside the country and sell them in the market, said the director of IKCO.

Moj news agency quoted Javad Najmeddin as saying that after the meeting with the director of France's Peugeot Jean-Marc Gales for the first time it was

agreed to produce and sell Peugeot brand cars outside the country.

He said, "We agreed to build Peugeot 206, 207 and Pars in Iran Khodro factories in countries such as Venezuela, Senegal and Syria."

The 405 GLX and 405 SLX models will also be produced in these countries, he added.

Najmeddin stated that this agreement shows IKCO's high capacity in promot-

ing joint ventures and producing Peugeot brand products in its international factories.

Iran Khodro is the largest vehicle manufacturing company in Iran, having an average share of 65 percent of domestic vehicle production.

Iran Khodro has received ISO 9001 from RW-TUV, Germany, as well as many other health, safety, and environment certificates including ISO 14001 and OHSAS 18001.

Iran, Belarus to set up joint trade council

MOSCOW — Iran and Belarus signed a memorandum of understanding to set up a joint trade council during the Iranian business delegation's visit to Minsk.

Based on the signed MOU, the two sides are to introduce their representatives to the council in one month, IRNA reported on Saturday. The 45-member Iranian business delegation headed for the Belarusian capital Minsk on Monday.

Iran's Chamber of Commerce, Industries and Mines Chairman Mohammad Nahavandian and Tehran Province's Commerce Organ-

ization Director Seyyed Ali Mousavi are supervising the delegation.

So far Nahavandian has held meetings with the Belarusian Industry Minister Alexander M. Radevich and the nation's deputy Agriculture ministers. During its one-week stay, the Iranian delegation plans to hold meetings with the Belarusian officials and businessmen to review the two countries' trade relations and discuss possible ways for removing the obstacles.

Iranian delegation consists of businessmen active in the fields of foodstuff, construction stones and materials, engineering services, and medical equipments.
